Sessions start at 2pm every Monday afternoon supervised play ends at 4pm, but players can carry on playing.

Is there a fixed programme of lessons?

The programme is fluid and responsive to our students' requests/feedback. Attendance at lessons is free to members. There is a table money charge of £1 per seat in the RealBridge practice session that follows.

On the first Monday of each month we run a seminar workshop on an Improver Level topic.

On other Mondays we run short refresher lessons followed by a mix of prepared and random deals.

Watcher facility in Real Bridge?

RealBridge has a great 'watcher' facility where up to four guests can see, hear, chat and watch the play of the current deal. You can replay 'movies' of previous boards played by any foursome at any table. Players and watchers can swap seats at any point in time. Some of our group find 'watching' more instructive than playing!

We have our own RealBridge lounge. Members regularly arrange spontaneous sessions via WhatsApp. Sunday evenings and Tuesday evenings are popular. You can also play Solitaire on No Fear without requiring a No Fear subscription– 80 instructive deals covering all aspects of play, with expert commentary.

For supervised or unsupervised RealBridge sessions there is a charge of £1 per seat. For Seminar/Workshop sessions the charge is £2 per seat.

You buy ten 'Play' tokens in advance. When your pot gets low the treasurer will let you know

Note that there is no charge for attending a session as a watcher (i.e. without taking a playing seat).
