If partner had bid a new suit, a wide-ranging bid that could have opening values or more, then you would have bid 1NT, and if partner had bid a dustbin 1NT (6-9 HCP) then you would have passed. Partner has shown 6-9 HCP so your chances of making game are very slim. Even 2NT could be too high.
